DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY

PERIOD : DECEMBER TO END OF MARCH

DURATION : 2 DAYS AND 1 NIGHT

DEPARTURE : 9 AM

DAY 1

9AM Check-in at the reception of the *Centre de vacances Ferme 5 étoiles* to fill out risk-awareness and medical forms.

Inspection of your winter gear. We can provide required clothes if needed.

9:30AM Go to the Kennel to meet your guide and your future fur companions.

With the help of your guide, you will choose the dogs that will form your team. They will become your companions for the 3 coming days! A little warm-up : Time to harness the dogs. Your guide will teach you how to drive your sled and here we go! You will learn what true energy is when the time to leave comes.

Noon Campfire lunch

PM Cruise through our trails towards your waterfront lodging. Gaze at the sunset during the last moments of this extraordinary day. Our yurts are fully equipped for your comfort with a rustic touch while the warmth of the wood stove completes your pleasure. After setting up and feeding the dogs, you will eat, in a cozy atmosphere, a delicious meal prepared by the farm with your guide.

DAY 2

7AM Gorgeous and plentiful breakfast prepared by your guide... much needed energy for another amazing day ahead.

- 9AM Your dogs wait readily after you. Time to harness them and to leave for another adventure. Today is a new day. The experience you've earned yesterday serves you well and you are ready for the next level.
- AM Now that you have full control of your sled and that your skills are proven you are ready for new challenges. Lunch time will serve to rest before undertaking the rest of the journey. Hot beverages and submarines will comfort you.
- PM The day is not over, the Fjord and its surroundings still have a thousand secrets for you to discover. Adrenalin, view points and unforgettable memories will be waiting for you.
- Late PM Return to the base camp filled with pride and emotion. The dogs you choose at the beginning of the trip are now your pack brothers. Forever they will be in your memories. For the last time, we remove the harness and put the dogs back to their place for a well-deserved rest (And lunch!). One last caress and their eyes beg you to return to them, as soon as possible.
